- Area 37 000 sq km
- 34 municipalities, 400 000 inhabitants
- City of Oulu 200 000 inhabitants
- Average age 39 years
- R&D investment over billion euros
 - > 4300 euros per capita







- Smart Specialisation Strategy
 - ICT (special focus on software) and it's applications in different industries and business areas
 - Value chain in basic industries: mining, steel and processing industries, wood industry
 - Clean technologies, incl. Energy
 - Health and wellness technology
